Overview

Assiut is one of the fastest growing cities in Egypt with strong informal development on the fertile banks of the river Nile. Dense new settlements quickly move into the agricultural land supply with and disposal infrastructure not catching up the progress.

In the creative design lab we develop concepts and designs for interactive infrastructures that link energy, water, food and waste flows and facilities addressing these challenges through a metabolic approach.
